AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S. 1991, Section 662, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 316, O.S.L. 1998 (74 O.S. Supp. 2000, Section 662), which relates to display of historical documents; clarifying terms; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 1991, Section 662, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 316, O.S.L. 1998 (74 O.S. Supp. 2000, Section 662), is amended to read as follows:

Section 662. The Secretary of State is hereby authorized and directed to establish secured display areas for the original Oklahoma State Constitution, photographs and other documents and articles of historical significance. The original Oklahoma State Constitution shall be displayed in a display case to be designated by the Secretary of State in the State Capitol Building. The display area shall be under the jurisdiction and control of the Secretary of State.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2001.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
