HOUSE BILL HB2189

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; requiring that certain certified teachers receive a pay raise; providing for noncodification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

Beginning with the 2002-03 school year, each teacher certified to teach in mathematics or science in a secondary school in each school district in this state shall receive a Five Thousand Dollar (\$5,000.00) pay increase.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2002.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
