AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to counties and county officers;
amending 19 O.S. 2001, Section 902.11, which relates
to rural road improvement district property record;
updating language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2001, Section 902.11, is amended to read as follows:

Section 902.11 To permit retirement of the bonded indebtedness of the rural road improvement district, it shall be the duty of the secretary of the board to prepare and keep a record which shall be known as the rural road improvement district property record. ~~Such~~ The record shall contain the names of the owners of the lands in the district as they appear on the tax rolls of the county or upon the deed records, the description of all property subject to ad valorem taxation, and the assessed value of ~~such~~ the property as shown by the records of the county assessor. No error in the names of owners or in the description thereof shall invalidate the levy of taxes provided for in the Oklahoma Rural Road Improvement District Act if sufficient description is given to identify ~~such~~ the property.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2002.
