AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to appropriations; making appropriation to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce; stating purpose related to recommendation of Oklahoma Military Base Closure Prevention Task Force; allocating funds; making appropriation to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education; stating purpose related to recommendation of Oklahoma Military Base Closure Prevention Task Force; stating legislative intent regarding allocation of funds; stating legislative intent regarding administrative expense; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Constitutional Reserve Fund of the State Treasury the sum of One Million Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$1,250,000.00) pursuant to the recommendations of the Oklahoma Military Base Closure Prevention Task Force to assist communities with strategic planning in order to prevent a military base closure or a military base realignment which would be detrimental to one of the affected communities. The appropriations shall be allocated as follows:

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Constitutional Reserve Fund of the State Treasury the sum of Two Million Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars Dollars (\$2,750,000.00) pursuant to the recommendations of the Oklahoma Military Base Closure Prevention Task Force to improve the educational systems that support affected communities and which assist strategic planning by the affected communities in order to prevent a military base closure or a military base realignment which would be detrimental to one of the affected communities. It is the intent of the Legislature that the appropriations made by this section be allocated for the purposes and in the amounts as follows:

Telecommunications Infrastructure	\$ 500,000.00
CASI (Center for Aircraft and Systems Support)	\$ 500,000.00
Lead Institutional Support	\$ 750,000.00
Collaborative Initiatives	\$1,000,000.00

SECTION 3. Of the amount appropriated by Section 2 of this act, it is the intent of the Legislature that not more than twelve percent (12%) of such monies shall be used for administrative expense.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
