AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution designating interchange of State Highway 77 and Interstate 35 as the Cleo Bradshaw Interchange; directing Oklahoma Department of Transportation to place permanent markers; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Cleo Bradshaw provided untold hours of service to achieve the creation of a new interchange linking State Highway 77 and Interstate 35; and

WHEREAS, the interchange of State Highway 77 and Interstate 35 shall provide a lasting testament to the dedication of Cleo Bradshaw.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 48TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the interchange of State Highway 77 and Interstate 35 be designated as "Cleo Bradshaw Interchange".

THAT the Oklahoma Department of Transportation shall cause permanent suitable markers to be placed upon the expressway bearing the name.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to Neal McCaleb, Secretary and Director of Transportation, to the members of the State Transportation Commission, and to Mrs. Cleo Bradshaw.
