AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution designating portion of State Highway 67 as the Veterans of Foreign Wars Highway; directing Oklahoma Department of Transportation to place permanent markers; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the Department of Defense is commemorating the 50th anniversary of the Korean War; and

WHEREAS, the ravages of time and the scars of war shall not diminish the heroic deeds of the veterans who fought during the Korean War; and

WHEREAS, the Bardon-Humphries Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 1327 honors the dedication of all veterans who served the United States of America on foreign soil; and

WHEREAS, the Bardon-Humphries Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 1327 serves members from Glenpool, Bixby, Jenks and South Tulsa County; and

WHEREAS, the naming of State Highway 67 will serve as a lasting tribute to the memory of all veterans who proudly served the United States of America.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 48TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the portion of State Highway 67 beginning at the intersection of State Highway 67 and United States Highway 64 in

Bixby extending east approximately 10 miles to the intersection of State Highway 67 and United States Highway 75A be designated as the "Veterans of Foreign Wars Highway".

THAT the Oklahoma Department of Transportation shall cause permanent suitable markers to be placed upon the highway bearing the name.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to Transportation Secretary Herschal Crow and Director of Transportation Gary Ridley, to the members of the State Transportation Commission, and to Mr. George Wilmott, Commander, VFW Post 1327.
