AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution stating legislative intent that a salary survey be conducted for the Grand River Dam Authority every two years; directing the Office of Personnel Management to discard certain recent survey results; directing Grand River Dam Authority to compile certain data on salaries; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature that a salary survey be performed by the Office of Personnel Management (OPM) for the Grand River Dam Authority (GRDA) every two years; and

WHEREAS, it is also the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature that such survey compare all jobs at the GRDA with similar positions at other electricity generating facilities only; and

WHEREAS, the most recent salary survey performed by the OPM did not provide such specific comparison information for all job classifications.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 48TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the OPM is hereby directed to discard the results of the most recent GRDA salary survey.

THAT the GRDA is hereby directed to compile data on electricity generating utilities market rates of pay in order to develop and adopt salary increases supported by the wage information obtained

from other utility/utilities salary surveys, to be in effect until the next OPM salary survey is produced.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to the Administrator of the Office of Personnel Management and to the General Manager of the Grand River Dam Authority.
