AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution honoring Ed Kellogg for his service to the State of Oklahoma; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Ed Kellogg has become a trusted and respected friend to the Oklahoma Legislature and the people of Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, Ed Kellogg has been a pilot for over 30 years and enjoys flying. An active member of the First Baptist Church in Talala, Oklahoma, Ed often goes on church missions overseas and enjoys a wide variety of sports and athletic activities; and

WHEREAS, Ed Kellogg has spent countless hours patiently responding to legislative inquiries regarding "when, where, and how soon can that road be built?"; and

WHEREAS, Ed Kellogg has decided to retire to enjoy the company of Janie, his loving wife of 34 years.
