AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Commission for Teacher Preparation; providing for the budgeting of funds in certain categories and amounts; requiring performance measures for budget categories; providing for duties and compensation of employees of the Oklahoma Commission for Teacher Preparation; limiting the salary of the Executive Director; providing budgetary limitations; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

OKLAHOMA COMMISSION FOR TEACHER PREPARATION

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2003, the Oklahoma Commission for Teacher Preparation shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

The Commission shall develop outcome-based performance measures for each budget category.

SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Commission for Teacher Preparation by law shall be set by the Executive Director of the Oklahoma Commission for Teacher Preparation. The salary of the Executive Director shall not exceed

Sixty-two Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$62,200.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2003. The Oklahoma Commission for Teacher Preparation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2003, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2002.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
