SENATE BILL 109

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S. 1991, Section 1809, which relates to the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Act; clarifying language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 1991, Section 1809, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1809. There are hereby created within the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department the Division of Lodges, the Division of Parks, the Division of Travel and Tourism and the Division of Special Events; provided, however, the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Commission shall have authority, by resolution, to create other divisions and may, by resolution, combine or abolish any or all such divisions, as deemed to be necessary to carry out its duties ~~under this act~~ pursuant to Section 1801 et seq. of this title. The Division formerly known as the Division of Marketing Services is hereby renamed the Division of Travel and Tourism.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2001.
