SENATE BILL 1268

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to tourism; amending 74 O.S. 2001, Section 1907, which relates to the Oklahoma Recreation and Development Revolving Fund; clarifying statutory language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 1907, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1907. A. The Oklahoma Recreation and Development Revolving Fund Advisory Board shall determine and shall recommend to the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Commission projects within the state that should be performed with money from the Oklahoma Recreation and Development Revolving Fund, and shall submit to the Commission no later than February of each year a list of those projects that the Board has determined should be performed with money from the revolving fund, compiled in order of priority.

B. The list shall be accompanied by estimates of total costs for the proposed projects.

C. The Board shall supply with each list a statement of the guidelines used in listing and assigning the priority of the proposed projects.

D. The Commission shall review the recommendations of the Board and shall determine, from the list provided by the Board, the projects to be funded, with money from the Oklahoma Recreation and Development Revolving Fund.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2002.
