SENATE BILL 1278

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to municipalities; amending 11 O.S. 2001, Section 22-127, which relates to residency requirements; stating exception; requiring mandatory residency for all permanent full-time employees hired after an effective date; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 2001, Section 22-127, is amended to read as follows:

Section 22-127. A. The municipal governing body by ordinance may designate which appointed officers and employees shall reside within the municipality; but except as provided by subsection B of this section police officers, firefighters and other municipal employees need not be actual residents of the municipality where they are employed in municipalities of five thousand (5,000) population or more, according to the latest federal census.

B. Notwithstanding any other provision of law or the provisions of any existing or future collective bargaining agreements, including, without limitation, collective bargaining agreements entered into pursuant to the fire and police arbitration law as provided in Sections 51-101 through 51-113, inclusive, of this title, the governing body of any municipality of three hundred thousand (300,000) population or more according to the latest federal census may, by ordinance, require all permanent full-time employees, including, without limitation, police officers and firefighters hired by the municipality after the effective date of

such ordinance to be actual residents of the municipality where they are employed.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2002.
