SENATE BILL 1299

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the State and Education Employees Group Insurance Board; requiring mutual consent before certain contracts may be amended; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1306.5 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A network provider facility contract may be amended at any time during the term of the contract but if it is amended then it shall only be amended by mutual written consent of duly authorized representatives of the State and Education Employees Group Insurance Board and the network provider.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2002.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
