SENATE BILL 1317

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to higher education; authorizing Northwestern Oklahoma State University to establish tuition and fees for students of Northwestern Oklahoma State University who are not United States citizens beginning with the 2002-2003 school year; prescribing certain minimum amount; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3218.15 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Notwithstanding any other provision in law, as a pilot program, beginning with the 2002-2003 academic school year, Northwestern Oklahoma State University is authorized to establish tuition and fees to be charged to students who are not United States citizens at an amount not less than is authorized for nonresident tuition for courses and programs at Northwestern Oklahoma State University.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2002.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
