SENATE BILL 134

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to poor persons; requiring promulgation of rules regarding guaranteed health care services to eligible Medicaid recipients by certain date; providing for noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

The Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board shall promulgate by September 1, 2001, rules that extend to twelve (12) months coverage of guaranteed health care services to eligible Medicaid recipients.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
