SENATE BILL 1440

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to counties and county officers; directing the State Commissioner of Health to provide an electronically transmitted list of registered deaths to all county sheriffs; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 514.4 of Title 19, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Beginning November 1, 2002, and each month thereafter, the State Commissioner of Health shall authorize the electronic transmission to the sheriff's office of every county a certified list of all registered deaths of residents of this state that have occurred within the state for the immediately preceding month. The sheriff's office shall use the transmitted list to ascertain the names of those individuals with outstanding warrants who are deceased, and shall thereafter delete such deceased person's name from the outstanding warrant list.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2002.
