SENATE BILL 1443

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to insurance; requiring health insurance carriers to furnish specified data to certain employers; requiring data to be provided within a certain time period upon receipt of written request; allowing request of data for specified prior time period; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4512 of Title 36, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Insurance carriers providing, or that have provided, health insurance to employees of employers of fifty (50) or more full-time-equivalent employees shall furnish to such employers, upon written request, aggregate claim data. The carrier shall provide the date within thirty (30) days of receipt of a written request for such data from the employer. The employer may request monthly aggregate claim data for any month up to two (2) years prior to the date of the written request.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
