SENATE BILL 1445

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to counties and county officers; authorizing the sheriff in certain counties to apply for grants; directing funding from grants to go directly into the sheriff's general revenue fund; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 529 of Title 19, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, the county sheriff in counties having a population of at least five hundred thousand (500,000) may apply for any grant which would help fund the office of the sheriff. The funds from such grants shall go directly into the sheriff's general revenue fund for the operation of the sheriff's office.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2002.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
