SENATE BILL 1475

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Constitutional Reserve Fund; making an appropriation to the Oklahoma Centennial Commission; stating purpose; requiring budgeting in certain categories and amounts; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

OKLAHOMA CENTENNIAL COMMISSION

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Centennial Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Constitutional Reserve Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of One Million Two Hundred Five Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-one Dollars (\$1,205,331.00), to be used for Oklahoma Centennial Military Projects.

SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2003, the Centennial Commission shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:
