AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Department of Central Services; providing for the disposal of certain real property; providing for the disposition of certain monies received; repealing Section 96, Chapter 433, O.S.L. 2001; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

DEPARTMENT OF CENTRAL SERVICES

SECTION 1. Pursuant to applicable provisions of law, the Department of Central Services may dispose of the surface of two tracts of real property, more specifically described as:

1. All that part of the Southwest Quarter (1/4) of Section Thirteen (13), Township Thirteen (13) North, Range Four (4) East of the Indian Meridian lying east of the right of way of the Santa Fe Railroad and containing 1 1/2 acres, more or less, and Southeast Quarter (1/4) of Section Thirteen (13), Township Thirteen (13) North, Range Four (4) East of the Indian Meridian, except a tract containing six (6) acres, more or less, lying west of the Santa Fe Railway, Lincoln County, Oklahoma.

2. Lot Five (5), Block Two (2), Sunnyside Addition and the south twenty (20) feet of Lot Two (2), Block Sixty-three (63), Original Town, Stillwater, Payne County, Oklahoma.

All monies received from the sale of the real property, except those monies necessary to pay expenses incurred by the Department of

Central Services pursuant to the sale and maintenance thereof, shall be deposited to the General Revenue Fund.

SECTION 2. REPEALER Section 96, Chapter 433, O.S.L. 2001, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
