SENATE BILL 1507

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public health and safety; creating the Certification Review Board for Assisted Living Facility Administrators; providing for membership appointment and terms of members; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-890.10 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. There is hereby re-created, to continue until July 1, 2007, in accordance with the provisions of the Oklahoma Sunset Law, the Certification Review Board for Assisted Living Facility Administrators.

B. 1. The Certification Review Board for Assisted Living Facility Administrators shall consist of nine (9) members as follows:

- a. the State Commissioner of Health, or a designee,
- b. two licensed medical practitioners,
- c. three certified assisted living facility administrators who have at least three (3) years' experience in operating an assisted living facility and who are members in good standing with a statewide assisted living association, and
- d. three representatives who are fifty-five (55) years of age or older, representing the general public.

2. The appointive members shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate.

3. The terms of all appointive members shall be three (3) years. Any vacancy occurring in the position of an appointive member shall be filled by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Senate, for the unexpired term.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2002.
