SENATE BILL 1526

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; requiring State Board of Education to develop uniform educational reporting system; specifying requirements of system; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-155 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

For the purpose of streamlining student data collection and reporting requirements of schools, the State Board of Education shall develop a uniform educational reporting system. Such system shall allow the interrelationship between student achievement and factors that influence performance to be analyzed while maintaining confidentiality of student-level data.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2002.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
