SENATE BILL 1563

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; prohibiting the movement of certain vehicles in certain area for certain time period; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 506 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Notwithstanding any other provision of law no semitrailer that is drawn by a truck-tractor shall be operated on Interstate Highway 44 from where the highway intersects with Interstate Highway 244 near the community of Oak Hurst, Oklahoma, east to where it reconnects with Interstate Highway 244 in the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, for a period of eight (8) years.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
