SENATE BILL 1582

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; amending 69 O.S. 2001, Section 1277, which relates to the Highway Advertising Control Act of 1972; clarifying statutory reference; requiring notification to be sent to certain permit holder after lapse of certain time period; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2001, Section 1277, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1277. A. The Transportation Commission is hereby authorized to enact and adopt rules ~~and regulations~~ for the issuance of licenses and permits and the charging and collection of permit fees for other than "on-premise" outdoor advertising structures as defined in this act.

B. The Department of Transportation shall have the authority to revoke any permit issued under Sections 1271 through 1285 of this title if the permit holder for any reason is no longer making lease payments for a period exceeding six months or other agreed-upon compensation to the landowner for use of the land where the ~~sign~~ structure is located. The Department shall notify the permit holder of such impending revocation via certified mail.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
