SENATE BILL 1600

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation; amending 74 O.S. 2001, Section 150.34, which relates to judicial background investigations; modifying requirement for certain number of agents assigned to certain duties; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 150.34, is amended to read as follows:

Section 150.34 Of the full-time-equivalent employees authorized for the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, at least one senior agent shall be employed for the purpose of conducting judicial background investigations requested by the Judicial Nominating Commission. When not conducting investigations for the Judicial Nominating Commission, the senior agent, or agents, may be involved in investigations as requested by the Council on Judicial Complaints and in other investigations as deemed appropriate by the Director of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation; provided, however, the first priority of the agent, or agents, will be to respond to requests of the Commission.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
