SENATE BILL 1605

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to poor persons; amending 56 O.S. 2001, Section 1025.4, which relates to violations and penalties; clarifying references; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 56 O.S. 2001, Section 1025.4, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1025.4 Any violation of the provisions of Sections ~~11 through 13~~ 1025.1 through 1025.3 of this title shall be a misdemeanor and, upon conviction or plea of guilty or nolo contendere, shall be punishable by a fine of not less than Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00), but not to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00). In addition to the fine, such violator may be imprisoned in the county jail for not more than thirty (30) days. Each day that such violation continues shall be considered to be a separate violation.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2002.
