SENATE BILL 1674

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public health and safety; requiring the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to develop plan to financially reward and reimburse certain facilities; requiring promulgation of rules; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5022.3 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall develop a plan to financially reward and reimburse long-term care facilities whose employees meet higher levels of expertise.

The Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board shall promulgate rules to enact the provisions of this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2002.
