AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state employees; amending 74 O.S. 1991, Section 840.6, as renumbered by Section 54, Chapter 242, O.S.L. 1994 (74 O.S. Supp. 2000, Section 840-1.6), which relates to the Office of Personnel Management; modifying statutory references; providing gender-neutral language; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 1991, Section 840.6, as renumbered by Section 54, Chapter 242, O.S.L. 1994 (74 O.S. Supp. 2000, Section 840-1.6), is amended to read as follows:

Section 840-1.6 The internal administrative organization of the Office shall be determined by the Administrator in such a manner as to promote the efficient and effective enforcement of ~~this act~~ the Oklahoma Personnel Act.

The Administrator may employ attorneys, accountants and other personnel as he or she deems necessary to carry out the duties imposed upon the Office. Employees of the Office shall be subject to the Merit System of Personnel Administration, unless otherwise exempted by Section ~~8 of this act~~ 840-5.5 of this title.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2001.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
