AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to Common Education; amending Section 1, Chapter 229, O.S.L. 1998; providing legislative intent; amending Section 1, Chapter 246, O.S.L. 1999; providing legislative intent; amending Section 7, Chapter 351, O.S.L. 1999; providing legislative intent; amending Section 2, Chapter 121, O.S.L. 2000; inserting legislative intent; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 229, O.S.L. 1998, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999, the sum of Forty Million One Hundred Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$40,115,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the financial support of public schools. It is the intent of the Legislature that of these funds Seventeen Million One Hundred Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$17,115,000.00) be directed for school district expenditures associated with increases in student population and increases in weighted per pupil categories pursuant to Section 18-201.1 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and Twenty-three Million Dollars (\$23,000,000.00) be directed for expenditures associated with increases in the minimum salary

schedule for teachers in Section 18-114.7 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 246, O.S.L. 1999, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Twenty Million Eight Dollars (\$20,000,008.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the financial support of public schools. It is the intent of the Legislature that these funds be directed for school district expenditures associated with increases in the student population and increases in weighted per pupil categories pursuant to Section 18-201.1 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 3. AMENDATORY Section 7, Chapter 351, O.S.L. 1999, is amended to read as follows:

Section 7. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Constitutional Reserve Fund of the State Treasury the sum of Seventeen Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$17,500,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for financial support of public schools. It is the intent of the Legislature that these funds be directed for school district expenditures associated with increases in the student population and increases in weighted per pupil categories pursuant to Section 18-201.1 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 4. AMENDATORY Section 2, Chapter 121, O.S.L. 2000, is amended to read as follows:

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001, the sum of One Billion One Hundred Thirty-six

Million Nine Hundred Thirteen Thousand Six Hundred Seventeen Dollars (\$1,136,913,617.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the financial support of public schools. It is the intent of the Legislature that of these funds Thirteen Million Six Hundred Three Thousand One Hundred Seventy-four Dollars (\$13,603,174.00) be directed for expenditures pursuant to Section 17-108.1 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
