SENATE BILL 36

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to elections; amending 26 O.S. 1991, Section 4-113, as amended by Section 14, Chapter 260, O.S.L. 2000 (26 O.S. Supp. 2000, Section 4-113), which relates to voter identification cards; modifying contents of voter identification card; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 1991, Section 4-113, as amended by Section 14, Chapter 260, O.S.L. 1994 (26 O.S. Supp. 2000, Section 4-113), is amended to read as follows:

Section 4-113. A. The Secretary of the State Election Board shall devise a voter identification card which shall be issued to every person who becomes a registered voter in ~~Oklahoma~~ this state. ~~Said~~ The front of the voter identification card shall contain such information as is necessary to determine a registered voter's eligibility. The back of the voter identification card shall contain the voter's congressional district, state house and senate district, county commissioner district and school district.

B. When a person registers to vote or changes ~~his or her~~ registration in any manner to require a new voter identification card, the county election board secretary in the county of the voter's residence shall transmit the new voter identification card as acknowledgment of the transaction which may be the notice required in Section ~~§~~ 4-103.1 of this ~~act~~ title.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2001.
