SENATE BILL 367

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to counties; authorizing counties to determine what constitutes a nuisance; providing for notice; providing for hearing; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 866.37 of Title 19, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Counties in this state shall have the right and power to determine what is and what shall constitute a nuisance within their respective county lines, but outside the corporate limits, and whenever it is practical to do so, such county shall have the power to summarily abate such nuisance after notice to the owner and provide an opportunity for the owner to be heard.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2001.
