SENATE BILL 385

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public health and safety; amending 63 O.S. 1991, Section 1-104, as amended by Section 2, Chapter 238, O.S.L. 1997 (63 O.S. Supp. 2000, Section 1-104), which relates to the State Board of Health; clarifying language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 1991, Section 1-104, as amended by Section 2, Chapter 238, O.S.L. 1997 (63 O.S. Supp. 2000, Section 1-104), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1-104. A. The State Board of Health shall elect annually from its membership a President, Vice President and Secretary. The Board shall adopt rules for its government, and may adopt an official seal for the State Department of Health. It shall hold such meetings as it deems necessary. Each member of the Board shall be paid travel expenses, as provided in the State Travel Reimbursement Act.

B. The Board shall have the following powers and duties:

1. Appoint and fix the compensation of a State Commissioner of Health;

2. Adopt such rules and standards as ~~it deems~~ are necessary to carry out any of the provisions of this Code;

3. Accept and disburse grants, allotments, gifts, devises, bequests, funds, appropriations, and other property made or offered to it; and

4. Establish such divisions, sections, bureaus, offices, and positions in the State Department of Health as ~~it deems~~ are necessary to carry out the provisions of this Code.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2001.
