SENATE BILL 480

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to game and fish; authorizing the Department of Wildlife Conservation to impose certain fee; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4-137 of Title 29, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

In addition to any other fees authorized by law, the Department of Wildlife Conservation is authorized to impose a processing fee of Five Dollars (\$5.00) for special use permits for controlled hunts awarded pursuant to the O.A.C. 800:25-29-2.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
