SENATE BILL 503

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to higher education; amending Section 2, Chapter 325, O.S.L. 1998 (70 O.S. Supp. 2000, Section 4662), which relates to Oklahoma State University/Tulsa; changing statutory reference to Oklahoma State University-Tulsa; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 2, Chapter 325, O.S.L. 1998 (70 O.S. Supp. 2000, Section 4662), is amended to read as follows:

Section 4662. On January 1, 1999, there shall be established as a successor to Rogers University in Tulsa a branch institution of Oklahoma State University which shall be known as Oklahoma State ~~University/Tulsa~~ University-Tulsa and shall offer upper division undergraduate courses and baccalaureate degree programs. No later than July 1, 2001, the Board of Regents for the Oklahoma Agricultural and Mechanical Colleges, in cooperation with the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education, shall have developed and implemented programs leading to baccalaureate degrees that can be earned at Oklahoma State ~~University/Tulsa~~ University-Tulsa. Beginning with the 2001 - 2002 academic year, degrees earned at Oklahoma State ~~University/Tulsa~~ University-Tulsa shall be designated as awarded by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education acting through Oklahoma State University; provided that dual degree programs may be offered at Oklahoma State ~~University/Tulsa~~

University-Tulsa and dual degrees may be awarded through Oklahoma State University and other institutions.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2001.
