SENATE BILL 550

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to game and fish; prohibiting the award of a special use permit for controlled hunts under certain conditions; requiring deer taken by special use permit to be counted against the statewide limit; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4-136a of Title 29, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any person, who is awarded a special use permit for a controlled hunt pursuant to the O.A.C. 800:25-29-2, shall not be awarded another permit for such controlled hunt until every person who applied in the same year for such controlled hunt has been awarded a permit. Any deer taken pursuant to this section shall be counted against the statewide deer limit.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
