SENATE BILL 564

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public health and safety; amending Section 1, Chapter 90, O.S.L. 1998 (70 O.S. Supp. 2000, Section 1-107.1), which relates to technology for educational and governmental purposes; clarifying outlining; expanding applications; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 90, O.S.L. 1998 (70 O.S. Supp. 2000, Section 1-107.1), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1-107.1 A. Unless otherwise specifically defined, technology is applied knowledge. For educational and governmental purposes, technology shall include, but not be limited to information:

1. Information technology, ~~telecommunications technology and implemental technology.~~ Information technology shall include including, but not ~~be~~ limited to:

- a. computers,
- b. computer hardware,
- c. scanners,
- d. multimedia material,
- e. facsimile,
- f. e-mail,
- g. computer software,
- h. CD ROM material or other magnetic media,
- i. computer simulations,

- j. video,
- k. the World Wide Web (WWW) or Internet,
- l. Listservs,
- m. multiuser domains, and
- n. other technology used in distance learning or distance education-;

2. Telecommunications technology ~~shall include~~ including, but not ~~be~~ limited to, local area networks and wide area networks-; and

3. Implemental technology ~~shall include~~ including, but not ~~be~~ limited to:

- a. implements,
- b. equipment, and
- c. instruments or devices that promote the technology education process and are employed in the science or study of the practical, industrial, or mechanical arts or applied sciences.

B. The provisions of subsection A of this section shall apply when related to the expenditure of public funds by educational, health and governmental entities.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2001.
