SENATE BILL 572

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to motor vehicles; requiring certain vehicles to be driven in the right lane; providing exception; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-301a of Title 47, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

All truck tractors, as defined by Section 1-183 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes, shall be driven in the right lane upon all turnpikes, interstates and four-lane divided highways in this state. Provided, however, such vehicles may be driven in the center lane on six and eight lane highways. A truck tractor may be driven in the left lane only when overtaking another vehicle pursuant to Section 11-303 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
