SENATE BILL 581

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; amending 70 O.S. 1991, Section 14-105, as amended by Section 2, Chapter 144, O.S.L. 1995 (70 O.S. Supp. 2000, Section 14-105), which relates to courses of instruction and training in vocational and technical education; updating obsolete references; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 1991, Section 14-105, as amended by Section 2, Chapter 144, O.S.L. 1995 (70 O.S. Supp. 2000, Section 14-105), is amended to read as follows:

Section 14-105. The ~~State~~ Oklahoma Department of ~~Vocational Career and Technical~~ Technology Education may operate and maintain, or otherwise provide for, courses of instruction and training in vocational and technical education courses and subjects, and charge students reasonable tuition fees for such instruction or training. The fees shall be deposited in a special fund, which is hereby created, to be known as the State Vocational-Technical Fund. The fund may be used to pay expenses incurred by the Department in operating and maintaining such classes, and payment therefrom may be upon vouchers signed by a person or persons designated by the ~~State~~ Oklahoma Board of ~~Vocational Career and Technical~~ Technology Education. The fund may also be used for the operation of the Mid-America Vocational Curriculum Consortium (MAVCC) for the purpose of developing and disseminating curriculum materials for the member states.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2001.
