SENATE BILL 588

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority; making an appropriation to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority; stating purpose; directing Authority to implement certain program; restricting use of appropriation; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2002, the sum of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to implement the health care insurance stabilization program for local government employees authorized in this section.

SECTION 2. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority is directed to implement a health care insurance stabilization program for insurance plans formed through the Interlocal Cooperation Act by eight or more counties pursuant to the authority granted in Section 169 of Title 51 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The program shall provide required capital funding for cash flow management in the payment of claims. The money appropriated by this section shall not be used for any other purpose.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2001.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
