SENATE BILL 601

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S. 1991, Section 1829.2, as amended by Section 3, Chapter 84, O.S.L. 1995 (74 O.S. Supp. 2000, Section 1829.2), which relates to positions assigned to the Welcome Center in the State Capitol Building; clarifying statutory language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 1991, Section 1829.2, as amended by Section 3, Chapter 84, O.S.L. 1995 (74 O.S. Supp. 2000, Section 1829.2), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1892.2 Effective July 1, 1991, all current and future positions of the Oklahoma Department of Tourism and Recreation which are assigned to the Welcome Center in the State Capitol Building shall become classified and subject to the provisions of the Merit System of Personnel Administration except as provided in Section 840-5.5 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

Effective July 1, 1991, all incumbent employees of the Oklahoma Department of Tourism and Recreation who are assigned to the Welcome Center in the State Capitol Building shall become subject to the provisions of the Merit System of Personnel Administration and shall be classified without regard to status or examinations. ~~Such employee~~ The employees shall be granted permanent status in the class of positions to which the employee's position is allocated by the Office of Personnel Management.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2001.
