SENATE BILL 781

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the worldwide web; creating a task force to study internet access by children; providing for membership, term, report, and travel reimbursement; providing for noncodification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

There is hereby created a task force to study internet access by children under sixteen (16) years of age and the potential of solicitation of such children by pedophiles or other dangers of unrestricted internet access. The task force shall be composed of seven (7) members as follows:

1. Two members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate;
2. Two members appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives; and
3. Three members appointed by the Governor.

The task force members shall serve one (1) year and shall be reimbursed for travel by the appointing authority as provided in the State Travel Reimbursement Act.

One year from the effective date of this act, the members of the task force shall submit a report on the findings to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the Governor.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2001.
