SENATE BILL 795

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending 21 O.S. 1991, Section 645, as last amended by Section 125, Chapter 5, 1st Extraordinary Session, O.S.L. 1999 (21 O.S. Supp. 2000, Section 645), which relates to assault and battery with dangerous weapon; modifying penalty; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 1991, Section 645, as last amended by Section 125, Chapter 5, 1st Extraordinary Session, O.S.L. 1999 (21 O.S. Supp. 2000, Section 645), is amended to read as follows:

Section 645. Every person who, with intent to do bodily harm and without justifiable or excusable cause, commits any assault, battery, or assault and battery upon the person of another with any sharp or dangerous weapon, or who, without such cause, shoots at another, with any kind of firearm or air gun or other means whatever, with intent to injure any person, although without the intent to kill such person or to commit any felony, shall, upon conviction is, be guilty of a felony punishable. The violator shall be punished by imprisonment in the State Penitentiary ~~not exceeding~~ for a term in the range of one (1) year to ten (10) years, ~~or by imprisonment in a county jail not exceeding one (1) year.~~

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and

be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
