SENATE BILL 815

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; requiring district boards of education to ensure observance of one minute of silence in schools; allowing students to exercise individual choice in silent activity; and providing for codification.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-101.2 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The board of education of each school district shall ensure that the public schools within the district observe one minute of silence each day for the purpose of allowing each student, in the exercise of his or her individual choice, to think, meditate, reflect, or engage in any other silent activity that does not interfere with, distract, or impede other students in the exercise of their individual choices.
