SENATE BILL 835

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; authorizing boards of education for independent school districts to issue a diploma to students completing graduation requirements of the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics; requiring the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics to provide certain notification to school districts; stating legislative intent; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1210.405 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Any board of education for an independent school district is authorized to issue a diploma of high school graduation to any student who completes the graduation requirements of the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics and who attended a district school immediately prior to attending the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics or whose residence for purposes of Section 1-113 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes is within the district.

B. The Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics shall notify the sending school district of each student meeting the graduation requirements.

C. It is the intent of the Legislature that boards of education for independent school districts adopt policies to allow students who attend the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics and whose residence for purposes of Section 1-113 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma

Statutes is within the district to participate in district functions and activities, including graduation ceremonies.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2002.
