AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to counties and county officers; authorizing the county clerk to set up certain system to pay warrants; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 19-266.1 of Title 19, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The county clerk of any county may develop a process to set up a debit system to electronically transfer funds to or to receive funds from any other county to pay for warrants.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
