SENATE BILL 879

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Corporation Commission; prohibiting the Corporation Commission from issuing order or rule requiring specific labeling of motor fuel containing ethyl alcohol sold by certain retail establishments; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 620 of Title 17, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Corporation Commission shall not promulgate any rule, nor issue any order which requires any specific labeling of motor fuel containing ethyl alcohol sold at any retail establishment within this state. Any such rule or order in effect on the effective date of this act shall be deemed null and void.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
