SENATE BILL 939

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state government; allowing election and application to participate in the State and Education Employees Group Health and Life Insurance Plans for county election board secretaries; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1315.1 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Upon election and application by the secretary of a county election board and subject to any underwriting criteria that may be established by the State and Education Employees Group Insurance Board, the Board shall extend the benefits of the State and Education Employees Group Health and Life Insurance Plans to the secretary of each county election board, if the county in which the secretary serves is not participating in such plans.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2002.
