SENATE BILL 959

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1776, which relates to larceny of domestic animals; clarifying language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1716, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1716. Any person in this state who shall steal any horse, jackass, jennet, mule, cow, or hog, shall be guilty of a felony and upon conviction shall be punished by confinement in the State Penitentiary for a term of not less than three (3) years, nor more than ten (10) years; and any person in this state who shall steal any sheep, or goat, shall be guilty of a felony and upon conviction therefor shall be punished by confinement in the State Penitentiary for a term not less than six (6) months, nor more than three (3) years. The word "horse" as used in this section ~~shall include~~ includes all animals of the equine species and the word "cow" ~~shall include~~ includes all animals of bovine species.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2002.
