SENATE BILL 962

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to higher education; stating legislative intent relating to the use of credit card issuers on state-supported higher education institution property; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3242 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

It is the intent of the Legislature that the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education and any organizations associated with state-supported higher education institutions cease entering into any contracts after July 1, 2002, with credit card issuers and cease any practices which allow credit card issuers to use space or facilities of a state-supported higher education institution for the purpose of taking applications for credit cards, issuing credit cards, or providing merchandise or other inducements in exchange for filling out an application for credit.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2002.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
