AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution relating to rules of the Department of Wildlife Conservation; waiving the thirty-legislative-day review period for proposed amendments to permanent rules OAC 800:25-7-12 and 800:25-7-13 relating to the taking of pheasant; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 308 of Title 75 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Legislature may waive the thirty-legislative-day review period for any rule which has been transmitted for legislative review; and

WHEREAS, on April 4, 2001, the Department of Wildlife Conservation submitted to the Legislature for its review, proposed amendments to permanent rules OAC 800:25-7-12 and OAC 800:25-7-13 relating to the taking of pheasant; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature recognizes the substantive value and importance of such proposed amendments to permanent rules.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 48TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Legislature hereby waives the thirty-legislative-day review period for proposed amendments to permanent rules OAC 800:25-7-12 and OAC 800:25-7-13.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to the Governor and the Director of Wildlife Conservation.
